Purpose:

Each year, the Marsh Prancing Leadership Saginaw Alumni Award will be presented to a Leadership Saginaw Graduate who displays consistent, active leadership in Saginaw County and for being a visible, positive community influence.

This honoree will receive the Marsh Prancing Leadership Saginaw Alumni Award at the Leadership Saginaw County Graduation Ceremony.

Criteria:

Nominees must be recognized leaders in the community who are graduates from Leadership Saginaw County Classes 1987-2014. Only nominees from graduating classes three years back, or more, from the existing graduating class are eligible.

Leadership nominations must include evidence of the nominee's:

1. Accomplishments that help strengthen Saginaw County.
2. Collaborative skills and service.
3. Active assistance to others in identifying and developing leadership potential in others.
4. Genuine commitment to Saginaw County and the communities within Saginaw County.
5. Appreciation for diversity in people and ideas.
6. Vision.
