Nominee Dave Maurer

Dave Maurer began his career in radio in 1967 at St. Ignace, Michigan and moved to the Great Lakes Bay Region in 1968. He joined WSGW in 1979 and has anchored morning newscasts on Newsradio 790 consistently for the past 43 years. He serves as Program Director for the station which has been a National Association of Broadcasters Marconi Award nominee twice. In 2000 Dave was also named Operations Director for all five Alpha Media stations in Saginaw.

Under Dave's leadership WSGW has been awarded the 2020 NAB Crystal Award recognizing Community Service. WSGW also won the 2020 NAB Service to America Award for the Sharing Hope Radiothon and station is a finalist for that award in 2021 for coverage of the 500 Year Flood in Midland and Gladwin Counties.

He received the Michigan AP Lifetime Achievement Award in 2005. Dave is past president of the Michigan Associated Press Broadcasters Association Board of Directors. He served six years on the National Associated Press Broadcasters Board. He also has served on a number of committees for the Michigan Association of Broadcasters. He is a past member of the Radio Television News Directors Association.

Dave has used his career in radio to impact his community. He directs a lot of time toward channeling publicity for many local non-profits. Working with the late Ken Boomer, owner of 5 local Tim Hortons Restaurants, Dave has help coordinate the annual Rescue Ministries of Mid-Michigan Sharing Hope Radiothon for 15 years. The radiothon is broadcast on all five Alpha Media stations. The Sharing Hope radiothon has raised over \$500,000 providing 16,500 nights of emergency shelter services for the homeless in Saginaw and Bay City.

For 25 years Dave has help to coordinate Salvation Army's Food for Families Campaign. WSGW works with local sponsors to collect food over four weeks in the fall to benefit the Salvation Army Chapters in Saginaw, Bay and Midland Counties. In addition to food items employees of William Kibbe and Associates have taken up collections each year just before Christmas and have given the Food for Families Campaign over \$80,000 to benefit the Salvation Army.

Dave is also very supportive of the Ojibway Island Fourth of July Celebration. Each year he is the voice of the fireworks introducing the show on Ojibway Island. He also produces the simulcast music played over 100.5fm for the fireworks.

Dave is the past president of the Bay Area Catholic Schools marketing committee. He has been a celebrity announcer for the annual Hoops for the Homeless basket game between Nouvel Catholic Central High School and Bay City All Saints Central High School. The annual event held at Delta College raises money for City Rescue Mission of Saginaw and Good Samaritan Rescue Mission of Bay City.

In 2016 Dave received the Rotary's Paul Harris Fellow Award for his efforts in promoting humanitarian causes in the Great Lakes Bay Region and surrounding areas.

Dave has been instrumental in organizing professional development workshops and seminars across the state. He has lectured for broadcast and journalism classes at various colleges and universities in Michigan. Dave has worked with many interns over the years and has conducted independent direct studies for six students, some of whom have gone on to outstanding careers in radio and tv. As Dave advanced in his career, he found great satisfaction in mentoring people in Michigan's smaller markets as well as consulting work. In recognition of

contributions to broadcast journalism and his community Dave was inducted into the Michigan Broadcasters Hall of Fame in 2021.

Combining his career in broadcast media with his passion for this region, and his numerous efforts to assist and improve the quality of life for all residents, it is with great honor and respect that I recommend Dave Mauer for the Robert H. Albert Community Service Award.

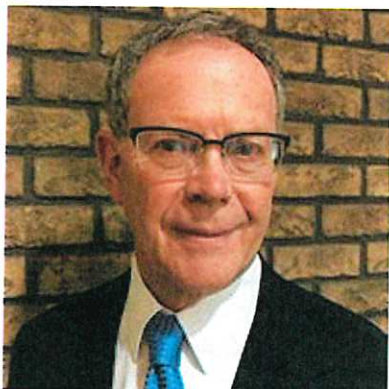

## DAVE MAURER, ALPHA MEDIA (SAGINAW)



Dave graduated from Career Academy of Broadcasting in Milwaukee in 1967. He later earned his B.A from Saginaw Valley State University. His first radio job began on August 22, 1967 as an announcer for WIDG Radio in St. Ignace. In July 1968 he joined WSAM in Saginaw as disc jockey and newscaster. In October 1968, he was hired as News Director of WXOX in Bay City and in 1977 he became General Manager of that station. In November 1979 he was recruited to become News Director for WSGW and in 1988 became both News Director and Program Director. In 2000, he was also named Operations Manager for the cluster. Dave has served as the morning anchor on WSGW for 42 years of his 54 years in radio.

He has served on both state and national boards for the Associated Press and is a longtime member of the MAB and RTNDA. Dave is a past President of the Saginaw Valley Press Club and the Michigan AP Board. Dave has served on a number of MAB Committees including planning for the annual conferences.

Dave and his news teams were named AP Station of the Year for 25 consecutive years beginning in 1985. While serving on the AP Board and MAB committees, Dave has been instrumental in organizing professional development workshops and seminars for broadcasters across the state. He has lectured for broadcast and journalism classes at various colleges and universities in Michigan. Dave also has worked with many interns over the years and has also conducted independent directed studies for six students, some of whom have gone on to outstanding careers in radio and TV. As Dave advanced in his career he found great satisfaction in mentoring and has critiqued audio and scripts as a courtesy to people doing news in Michigan's smaller markets as well as some consulting work.



In 2005 Dave received the Michigan AP Lifetime Achievement Award for his contributions to the industry and in 2016 he was named a Paul Harris Fellow by Rotary International for his coverage and contributions to humanitarian causes in Northeast Michigan.

Under Dave's leadership WSGW has been awarded the 2020 NAB Crystal Award recognizing Community Service. WSGW also won the 2020 NAB Service to America Award for the Sharing Hope Radiothon and the station is a finalist for that award in 2021 for coverage of the 500 Year Flood in Midland and Gladwin Counties.

Dave has been a format leader for one of his stations previous companies, Nextmedia. He currently serves as Operations Manager for Alpha Media's 5 station cluster in Saginaw and is Program Director for 100.5 and 790 Newsradio WSGW, in addition to co-hosting the Morning Team Show and anchoring newscasts.

Dave and his wife RoseMary live in Bangor Township near Bay City. He and his adult sons are avid anglers who have pursued fish in Canada, Lake Tahoe, several Michigan lakes and often on Saginaw Bay.
