Things to know

A couple of details

- Participants need to wear closed-toed shoes.
- Clothing should not be too loose or baggy as it can get caught on ladders and other equipment.
- You will be provided with safety glasses, construction hat, gloves and all the tools
 and supplies needed. If you have people that have favorite hand tools, they are
 welcomed to bring them, but otherwise everything will be provided.
- Wear clothes you don't mind getting ruined... you never know
- We will provide coffee and donuts for the morning and water to drink throughout the day

What to Bring

Please bring the following:

- Closed shoes (sneakers or work boots)
- A snack if you are hypoglycemic/diabetic
- Medication you may need, if you take any
- A great attitude and flexibility!

Volunteer Form

We are attaching a Volunteer form. You can have everyone fill it out before and then bring them on the volunteer day. This will speed up the process a little bit. If they do not bring one or forgot it, they will be available there. **Young people under 18 yrs. old need a guardian's signature on the form.**

You have already contacted us to let us know your group is coming and we have made arrangements of date and time.

Information for groups with young people

**Even though you are not planning to have young people as part of your group, we would like everyone to understand the restrictions of minors volunteering.

Age Restrictions

The State of Michigan has regulations we need to follow. We cannot have anyone younger than 14 on a work site. That is Michigan Law. If you have anyone younger than 14, we may be able to arrange for a landscaping project.

14-15 year olds can be on paint projects where there are no power tools on site. They cannot use a ladder/scaffold and be more than 6 feet off the ground.

16-17 year olds can be on an active construction sites with power tools, but cannot use power tools. They also cannot use a ladder/scaffold more than 6 feet off the ground. 18 year old and above are considered adults. They can sign for themselves, be on active construction sites and use power tools.

Supervision of young people

All young people need to be supervised by adults at a 1 adult to 6 young people ratio. We do not provide supervision for your young people. The adults must come with them.
